VOTE IN PENNSYLVANIA'S PRIMARY ELECTION ON JUNE 2

Recent changes to Pennsylvania's voting laws (Act 77) will make voting easier and safer in Pennsylvania's Primary Election on June 2.

It is no longer necessary to provide an excuse to use a mail-in ballot. The deadline to apply for a no-excuse mail-in ballot is May 26. For your own safety and the safety of poll workers, please consider this option. Apply for a mail-in ballot today at www.votespa.com

You will receive a ballot in the mail. It must be returned the elections office by 8:00 p.m. on the day of the election. You may put it in the mail or take it to the county board of elections.

For new voters, the last day to register to vote in the Primary is May 18. Use the www.votespa.com website to register to vote, to apply for a mail-in or absentee ballot, or for more detailed information.

The first mandated paid sick days and paid family leave in some COVID-19 related situations ('The Families First Coronavirus Response Act;' 'The Emergency Family and Medical Leave Act Expansion'). The second mandated significant unemployment benefits for workers ('The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act).
